



MISSION IMPOSSIBLE

Suits ages 30 months – unlimited



What you'll need:

- Long thin corridor, landing or hallway
- Ribbon, streamers or masking tape (or tape that will not damage walls)

What you do:

1. Create a web across the walls.
2. Ask the children to move through it without touching any of the ribbon/tape.
3. If a piece of tape is unstuck, they lose and have to start again.
4. Extend this to any other spaces or the garden. Allow your child to suggest places to play it.
5. Perhaps you can try it as well.

Children are dexterous and flexible but younger children haven't yet got a full grasp of their own spatial awareness. This allows them to try out where their body is in comparison to another object.

Another idea to extend upon spatial awareness is cardboard box play with lots of fabrics and connecting materials, such as tape and string.
